



GRANTS FOR SENIORS PROGRAM

Member for Flinders Liz Penfold said seniors on Eyre Peninsula will benefit by more than \$20,000 in the latest round of the Grants for Seniors Program.

“The grants cover a wide range of activities in health, education and recreation, and will lift the quality of life for our seniors,” she said.

She congratulated the awardees on their successful applications, and encouraged groups to put in an application if they have not done so previously or to re-apply if their application was unsuccessful in this round.

“These grants can make a big difference to groups whose only funds come from members and voluntary fundraising,” she said.

Development grants:

- Mid West Women’s Health Advisory Group for a 12-week learn to swim program for seniors in the Mid West Region \$2,706
- Council of Aboriginal Elders of SA (Port Lincoln Forum) to provide guidance and education products for healthy living \$7,805
- Spencer Institute of TAFE Wudinna Campus for elementary computing classes for seniors in Cowell, Elliston and Wudinna \$4,130.50.
