



**FLINDERS SPORTING, COMMUNITY RECREATION
CLUBS BENEFIT FROM ALMOST \$400,000 FUNDING**

Sporting and community recreation clubs are among groups in the electorate of Flinders receiving almost \$400,000 in State Government funding.

Recreation and Sport Minister Iain Evans says the State Government wants South Australians to have access to quality facilities so the number of people participating in sport on a local level will increase.

"This Government is now spending \$23 million over three years on community sport and recreation facilities, a dramatic increase on the previous sum of \$6 million over three years."

Member for Flinders Liz Penfold congratulated the successful applicants on the quality of their submissions.

"Sport and recreational facilities on Eyre Peninsula are established and maintained by volunteers," she said. "I am delighted that these grants will add to the positive work that so many are doing for the benefit of their communities."

Successful applicants in Flinders include:

Ceduna Pistol Club Inc. \$4,000.00 Upgrade of toilet and shower facilities within existing clubrooms.

Central Areas Sports Complex \$8,179.75 Upgrade lighting facilities on football oval.

Cummins Memorial Recreation Centre Inc \$14,000.00 Construction of a multi purpose building adjacent to the oval for administration, scorers and storage use.

District Council of Le Hunte \$13,226.00 Re-development of Wudinna's only public playground at Apex Park.

Kimba Golf Club \$8,955.25 Installation of easy access tee blocks and dispose of hazardous oil conditioned sand.

Kyancutta Ramblers Golf Club Inc \$6,325.00 Improvements to the clubrooms including upgrading the bar area, repair and weather proofing of surrounds

Minnipa Sports Club Inc \$69,750.00 Upgrade of netball courts and incorporation of three tennis courts

Port Lincoln Bowling Club \$16,750.00 Improvements to the facility, including extension of bowling green, installation of ramps for wheelchair access and installation of lights

Port Lincoln Gymnastics Club Inc \$85,050.00 Construction of a stadium for gymnastics and kindergym in Port Lincoln

Port Lincoln Table Tennis Association \$17,050.00 Installation of new new tongue & groove floor boards and sealing of floor.

Port Neill Progress Association \$17,965.00 Construction of retaining wall at Jetty head incorporating seating and shade, secure wheelchair and disabled access to the jetty and watering system for lawned area

Rudall Community Sports Club \$16,737.00 Upgrading of shelter and playground amenities at club

Smoky Bay & Districts Community Club Inc. \$27,450.00 Install sub surface irrigation and raise oval surface

Tumby Bay Pistol Club Inc \$2,250.00 Upgrading of pneumatics on targets

Ungarra & Districts Community Sports Club \$58,995.00 Installation of automatic irrigation system for oval and constructing concrete courts for tennis, netball and basketball.

Warrambo Community Club \$32,500.00 Extensions to existing clubrooms including new football change room and showers, upgrade existing changerooms and showers incorporating a disabled toilet
