



LOCAL CLUBS GET OLYMPIC EQUIPMENT

The Olympic Games held in Sydney last year have had a positive spin-off for two Eyre Peninsula clubs.

Member for Flinders Liz Penfold said the Office for Recreation and Sport purchased new gymnasium equipment for use by visiting gymnastics teams who used Adelaide as a base for pre-Olympic training.

This equipment has now been offered to community gymnastics and kindergym clubs, with Cummins Gym Club and Port Lincoln Gymnastics Club being successful in their applications.

Cummins will receive a landing mat and vaulting horse/H frame, while Port Lincoln will acquire a sprung floor.

Mrs Penfold said the equipment will be a welcome addition to facilities and will reinforce funds received from Active Club grants.

"The next round of Active Club grants is in October therefore I encourage those who have a small project to prepare their applications," she said.

Twelve organisations received grants totalling more than \$30,000 in the round that has just been finalised.
